

The Nursing Division received 167 applications for the Traditional Track. 34 applicants were not qualified due to low GPA or PAX entrance exam not taken. 95 students were qualified with a PAX score of 102 or above. We accepted 92 students for Spring 2019 with points ranging from 69-106.5

Beginning November 2nd, 2018 potential applicants may register to take the PAX entrance exam as many times as necessary to reach the 102 score. We don't recommend taking it again if the 102 has been achieved. We accepted the top 92 qualified students according to their points if they had at least 102 on the PAX. (For future semesters, if we do not have enough applicants with PAX scores = 102, we will accept students with < 102 and will rank them according to points).
