## NORTHWEST MISSISSIPPI COMMUNITY COLLEGE HSE SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Howard Carpenter High School Equivalency Scholarship is awarded to residents of the eleven county Northwest district who have obtained GED scores of ***500+ testing prior to January 1, 2002, 2500+ testing between January 2002-January 2014, and 600+ after January 1, 2014.*** If the student took the HiSET the score must be 75+. The awards will be in the amount of \$750 per semester toward the cost of tuition and are for full-time Fall/Spring entering freshmen only. The recipient must enroll and maintain 15 or more hours with a 2.0 grade point average. In order to receive the scholarship eligible individuals must provide Northwest with the following information:

- (1) Application for Admission to Northwest Mississippi Community College- Complete and attach a second copy of your GED transcript.
- (2) Application for Howard Carpenter HSE Scholarship- Be sure to attach a copy of your official GED transcript/HiSET scores to the application. If you do not have a transcript, you may visit [www.GED.com](http://www.GED.com)
- (3) Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov)- In order to receive a scholarship award you must complete the FAFSA.
