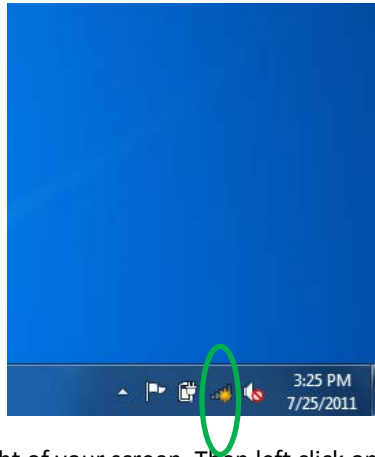
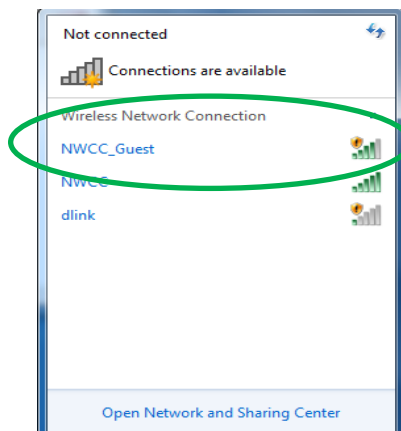


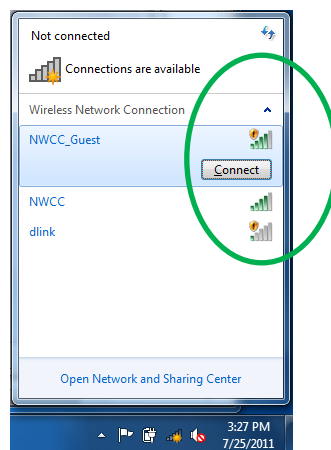
Accessing the Wireless Network at Northwest



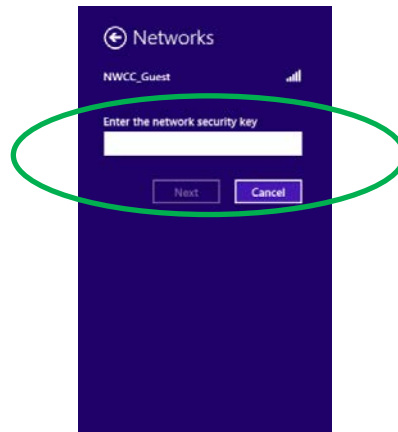
1. Look for the towers in the bottom right of your screen. Then left click on the icon.



2. This is the next screen you will see. Left click on NWCC_Guest.



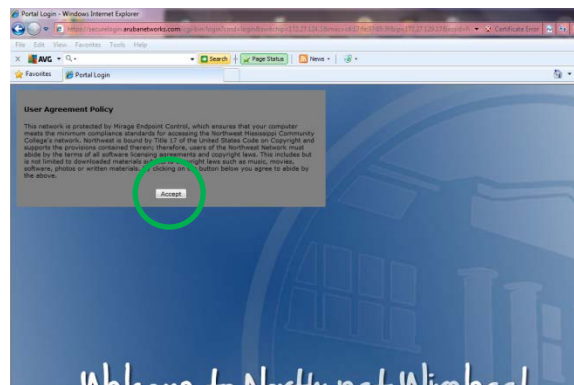
3. Next click on connect button.



4. You will see a password Screen. Type in the password **“gorangers”**

5. The user agreement policy page explains the rules and use of NWCC internet. In order to gain access to the internet you must read and agree to this policy. Once you have accepted the agreement policy, you can type in the address you wish to browse.



Mac Users Hints

If you do not have the Java app, go to www.java.com and download it (You will have to do this off campus). If you are not sure if you have Java, go to “Finder” and in the search window type “Java app”.

Once Java is loaded, Go to the Java app, click on the “Security” tab and click on “Edit Site List”. Add the following:

Try resetting Safari: Open Safari click on “Safari”, “Reset Safari”, “Reset everything” and then quit Safari.
