American College Test (ACT)

Take ACT late during your Junior year or early during your Senior year. Request your scores to be sent to: NWCC- code 2228. The ACT residual test is available during the summer.

Applications for Scholarships

Apply online at www.northwestms.edu/scholarships by April 1 deadline. Those who qualify and are awarded a scholarship will be sent a Scholarship Acceptance Form to be signed and returned. Competitive Scholarships (band, music, athletic, cheerleading, etc.) are awarded by respective departments. If interested, contact the person in charge of the department. Audition dates are available.

Financial Aid

- **FAFSA application is required.** Pell Grant money could take the place of awarded scholarship money.
- Complete the free application for FAFSA online at www.fafsa.gov to qualify for Pell Grant, Work Study or Loans. Northwest's Federal School code is 002427.
- Complete all forms as soon as possible after January 1st of the year you plan to attend college.

- Applications received first will be given priority. Out of district students must submit an application by May 31st.
