### Who can Pre-register?

If you are a current Northwest student or have completed all of the requirements for admission, you can pre-register for classes! Visit the Northwest website at [www.northwestms.edu/admissions](http://www.northwestms.edu/admissions) for information on the admissions process. PLEASE NOTE: New, first-time career and technical students must meet with an adviser, who will enter their first semester schedule.

### Important Dates/When to Register

April 3-6, Monday-Thursday	Pre-registration for summer & fall 2017—8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. (day & online); 4:30-6:30 p.m. (evening & online)
April 7, Friday	Pre-registration for summer & fall 2017—8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. (all classes)
April 10-28	Pre-registration for summer & fall 2017—By appointment with adviser (all classes)
May 22-26, Monday-Friday	Pre-registered students complete registration process online (first term summer day & summer online)
May 30, Tuesday	Pre-registered students complete registration process on campus—8 a.m.-3:30 p.m. (first term summer day & summer evening); open registration for summer evening & online—4:30-7 p.m.; classes begin (summer online)
May 31, Wednesday	Open Registration for first term summer day, summer evening & online—8 a.m.-3:30 p.m.
June 1, Thursday	First term summer day & summer evening classes begin; late registration begins
June 30, Friday	Pre-registered students complete registration process online (second term summer day classes)
July 3, Monday	Pre-registered students complete registration process online & on campus—8 a.m.-noon (second term summer day classes)
July 5, Wednesday	Second term summer day classes begin; late registration begins
Aug. 7, Monday	Pre-registered students complete registration process online (fall day & evening)
Aug. 8-9, Tuesday-Wednesday	Pre-registered students complete registration process online or on campus—8 a.m.-7 p.m. (fall day, evening & online); Open Registration for fall evening & online—4:30-7 p.m.
Aug. 10-11, Thursday-Friday	Open Registration for fall day, first mini-term & online—8 a.m.-3:30 p.m.
Aug. 14, Monday	Fall day, first mini-term & evening classes begin; late registration begins
Aug. 18, Friday	Last day to register
Aug. 21, Monday	Online classes begin (course sites open)
Oct. 11-13, Wednesday-Friday	Open Registration for second day & online mini-term
Oct. 16, Monday	Second session day & online mini-term classes begin; late registration begins

## How to Pre-register

1. Meet with your adviser. You may find out who is assigned as your adviser by logging into myNWCC and selecting View My Information under the Student Information option. The adviser is shown in the last section on this page.
2. Your adviser may enter your schedule, or if you prefer the adviser may 'web authorize' you to pre-register yourself online in myNWCC by selecting Registration under the Scheduling option.

**PLEASE NOTE:** You may not complete your registration and pay fees at this time, but **must do so May 22-30 (summer first term), June 30-July 3 (summer second term), or Aug. 7-9 (fall)** or your class schedule will be dropped from the system and you will have to select your classes again during open registration.

## Viewing the Summer & Fall 2017 Schedules

1. Click on myNWCC on the Northwest website: [www.northwestms.edu](http://www.northwestms.edu)
2. Click on the Course Schedule tab at the top of the Login screen. The following screen will appear.

3. Select the Term SU2017 (summer) or FA2017 (fall) from the dropdown box.
4. You can then select the appropriate department, course or the campus you want to attend to search for the courses you would like to display. You may also click the boxes next to the days of the week if looking for a class on specific days to meet your schedule.

If you are not sure what courses you need to enroll in that will apply to your degree, login to myNWCC and check your Degree Plan under Student Records for valid courses in your program.

## Looking for alternatives to traditional classes?

### MINI-TERM CLASSES

Mini-terms were developed for students who wish to take courses over an eight-week span, instead of a traditional semester. Students who want to expedite their degree plan to graduate early may take advantage of these courses. Mini-term classes in a variety of academic and career-technical course subjects are available on all campuses as well as online through the college's eLearning program. Fall 2017 mini-terms will be held Aug. 14 (Aug. 21 for online)-Oct. 6 (first session) and Oct. 16-Dec. 8 (second session).

### ONLINE CLASSES

Online courses were developed to increase access to Northwest courses by adults and other students who cannot attend campus-based classes because of work, family responsibilities or distance from campus. The typical student will usually devote around 8 hours per online course per week for both online and distance learning.
