Application Requirements:

- Must be a Mississippi Resident
- · Be at least 18 years of age or older
- Submit a clean DOT drug screen
- Pass a DOT physical
- Hold a High School Diploma or High School Equivalency
- Score a Silver Level on the National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC) exam
- Hold a valid CDL Class A Permit
- Complete a utility lineman program application

What will you learn over the course of your training?

- Drive commercial vehicles, maneuver, back up, and park a trailer
- Explain all aspects of the APPA Safety Manual
- Make connections of meter loops, transformers, and other equipment on de-energized poles
- Assist with the framing and installation of utility poles and apparatus on the ground
- Read and understand general information in the REA spec book
- Safely operate vehicles and equipment (bucket trucks, digger derrick trucks, etc.)
- Differentiate between an energized and de-energized structure and recognize hazards
- Make basic connections and disconnections
- Check voltage/amperes
